Dr. Louie Mavrogiannis is available to speak at your event on The Role of Hospices in Our Community.

Dr. Mavrogiannis has provided family medicine and palliative care throughout the GTA for the last sixteen years. His focus on palliative care comes from a belief that continuity of care incorporates all aspects of a persons' lifecycle from the beginning to the end.

He completed his MD Ph.D. at The University of Toronto, and is an adjunct lecturer in Faculty of Medicine, Department of Physiology. He has been awarded two consecutive Excellence in teaching awards from the Department of Physiology.

He is the Medical Director of The Dorothy Ley Hospice as well as the lead physician for The Dorothy Ley Hospice Community Outreach Palliative Program. He is a member of the hospice board of directors which focuses on community outreach and fund development.

Dr. Mavrogiannis is a member of the Hospice Palliative Care Association, The Canadian Society of Palliative Care and The Ontario Medical Association section on Palliative Care. He is involved with the Local Health Integration Networks through his administrative work with service delivery providers, long-term care homes and family medicine and community health centres. He previously chaired the multidisciplinary planning committee for Mississauga-Halton community Care Access Centre.
